5.2 (a)(i) Amend to read: the existing level of treatment, capacity of treatment

plant and associated equipment including reed bed (constructed

wetland);

5.7 Amend 1<sup>st</sup> sentence to read: Where the assessment ... ... the

licensee shall install UV disinfection, other appropriate disinfection systems or alternative proposals for the relocation of the discharge.

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork County Council for the waste water discharge relating to the Cloyne agglomeration, Register of Licence No D0298-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
