The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use that the Agency approve the Recommended Decision to grant a Waste Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Decision; Summary report of the Inspector dated 6 July 2010; one Third Party submission; and one licensee submission. The Directors noted that this was a review of Waste Licence No. W0161-01 initiated by the EPA, issued by the Agency on 25 June 2004.

4.4.1 Amend 1st sentence to read: Within 18 months of commencement of waste activities at the facility, *the* licensee shall prepare or part thereof.
