Dear Mr. Grant

I refer to my letter to Office of Climate, Licensing & Resource Use of July 27<sup>th</sup> 2010 advising that our client Greenstar North-East will shortly be applying to the EPA for a review of its licence W0146-01.

You phoned me on Wednesday September 1<sup>st</sup> reminding me that there is another Greenstar review application in train and it seemed logical at this stage that both reviews would be amalgamated into one.

The other review application was submitted in December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2008 however (reading the document register on the EPA web site) the only action on the Agency's part was to acknowledge the documentation receipt (06-01-2009) specified body notification (06-01-2009) and change of register number from W0146-02 to W0146-03 (24-06-2009). I note that the usual application documentation validation exercise has yet to be done.

Having consulted with our client, we agree with your proposition that both applications can be amalgamated as one. While noting that the application was never validated by the Agency we nonetheless, on behalf of our client, and in accordance with Article 21-(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, will withdraw the application documents submitted on December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2008, on lodging of the new application.

The application referred in my letter of July  $27^{th}$  2010 will be submitted in the near future. You might advise whether the application fee ( $\mathfrak{C}31,000.00$ ) will be returned directly to our client or retained and set against the fee for the forthcoming application.
