I wish to protest at the proposed site location of the Bio Power plant in Tibohine. The access road to where this plant is to be situated feeds directly off the N5 on a double bend controlled by double white lines where these lorries will have to stop and then cross the main road to get to the proposed site, the speed limit on this is 100km per hour.
