Introduction

Cork County Council Southern Division was granted Waste Water Discharge Licences on 20th July 2010 by the Environmental Protection Agency for the agglomerations of:


- (1) Cobh (Reg No. D0054-01)
- (2) Passage West/Monkstown (Reg. No. D0129-01)
- (3) Ringaskiddy Village (Reg. No. D0436-01)

The purpose of these clerical amendments (Amendment A) is to rectify a clerical error on page 4 of these licences. In Paragraph 2, line 5 under heading "Decision & Reasons for the Decision", the word "objections" should read "objectives".

Recommendation

I recommend that the licence amendments be approved as set out in the attached recommended Clerical Amendments. This is provided for under Regulation 33(1)(a) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations, 2007. Such amendments do not result in the relevant requirements of Regulation 6(3) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations, 2007 ceasing to be satisfied.
