re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004

Dear Mr Ó Súilleabháin

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence for DOK Quarrystone Ltd relating to a facility at Garranmore, Cashel, Co. Tipperary. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 5 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004. A period of more than two weeks elapsed between the publication of the newspaper notice, required in accordance with Article 5 of the Regulations, and the making of this application.

I am also directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 6 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice published in respect of the application contravenes Article 6(c) of the Regulations in that it did not specify the quantity of waste involved.

I am also directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice as erected or fixed on the facility or premises contravenes Article 7(3)(b) of the Regulations in that it did not specify the quantity of waste involved.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations, to (a) publish a further notice in a newspaper that provides all relevant information required by the Regulations and (b) erect or fix a new site notice. The site notice shall be maintained in position for a period of two months.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:


- (a) an original copy of the whole page containing the newspaper notice; and
- (b) a copy of the revised site notice.



The evidence requested should be submitted within one month of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies on an electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
