	APPLICATION FOR A WASTE LICENCE FROM HI-VOLT IRELAND LIMITED, BALLYDUFF, THURLES, CO. TIPPERARY, LICENCE REGISTER W0267-01

Further to the Board's consideration of this application on the 17th August 2010, two points of clarification were raised, as follows:

- Does the applicant own the lands on which the installation is situated, and
- Is there any information in the application concerning the noise impact due to the operation of the shredder during night-time hours, as proposed in the application, specifically with regard to the relevant noise limit of 45 dB_A?

The licence application has been consulted on both these points. The applicant is identified as the landowner of the site in Section B.1 of the application (Ref. Figure WLA-01).

With regard to noise impact, some information on the impact of the operation of the shredder is provided, but this is not sufficient to determine whether this impact would cause a breach of the night-time noise limit of $45 dB_A$ at nearby noise sensitive locations. Given that the proposed operating hours for the shredder coincide with just one "night-time" hour, 07.00-08.00 a.m., it could be considered reasonable to limit the operational hours of the shredder to daytime hours only, until it can be demonstrated by the licensee that noise impact will not breach $45 dB_A$.
