Dear Ms. O'Callaghan,

I wish to withdraw our application for a waste licence review reference number W0107-02 applied for on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2009.

The licence review application relates to a proposed expansion of our facility that would involve changes to the licence area and the construction of a new building. The sole reason for the withdrawal is that planning permission for the new building has been refused.

Based on discussions with the planning authority, there is no likelihood of planning permission being granted for any new buildings in the future, therefore we have no choice other than to abandon the project and consequently the revision of the Licence is no longer required.

Given the significant costs incurred in preparing the Licence Application, we request the Agency consider exercising its discretionary powers under Article 45 (1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, to refund up to half of the application fee.'
