Dear Mr Fay,

I refer to your application for a review of your Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) licence, which was received on 21 June 2010 and further information received on the 15 September 2010.

I am to advise that in accordance with the provisions of Section 90 of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2007, you are requested to supply the following additional information so that the Agency may complete a comprehensive assessment of the IPPC application:

- 1. Provide a suitable scaled map showing the route of the surface water drains from the discharge points SW1 and SW2 to the streams identified on the map provided as further information received on the 15th September 2010.
- 2. Provide the grid reference of the surface water monitoring and discharge points. SW2, as identified in further information received on the 15 September 2010, is outside the site boundary, clarify access to the surface water manhole SW2 and identify if the manhole has been installed.
- 3. Confirm that the leak detection inspection manholes have been constructed as per the drawing submitted as further information, received 15 September 2010.
- 4. Clarify the difference in annual slurry production figures submitted in support of licence application Reg. No. P0696-01 compared with the figures presented for the existing and proposed activity in the Environmental Impact Statement.
- 5. Please address bullet point no. 4 of paragraph 2(b), Schedule 6 of S.I. 600 of 2001 in relation to the Environmental Impact Statement submitted in support of the licence review application.
