Dear Mr McGrath

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is considering a waste licence application for the facility at Windtown, Dunsany, Co. Meath (waste permit Register No. WMP 2006/13 granted to Lyndon Douglas on 2 April 2007). Lyndon Douglas applied to the EPA for a waste licence on 18 February 2009 for this facility. The EPA received a fax dated 24 July 2010 from Lyndon Douglas on 19 August 2010 which stated that the facility is closed and is no longer accepting waste. Lyndon Douglas stated that he no longer wishes to proceed with his application for a waste licence with the EPA.

The EPA seeks confirmation from Meath County Council that the facility

1. is no longer importing waste,

2. is or will be or is capable of being returned to beneficial use and

3. is closed and completed in accordance with the waste permit WMP2006/13 and to Meath County Council's satisfaction.
