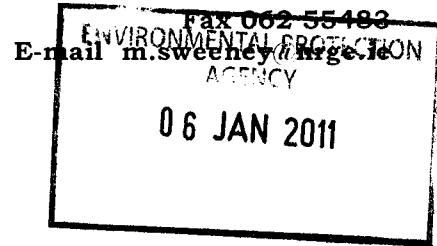



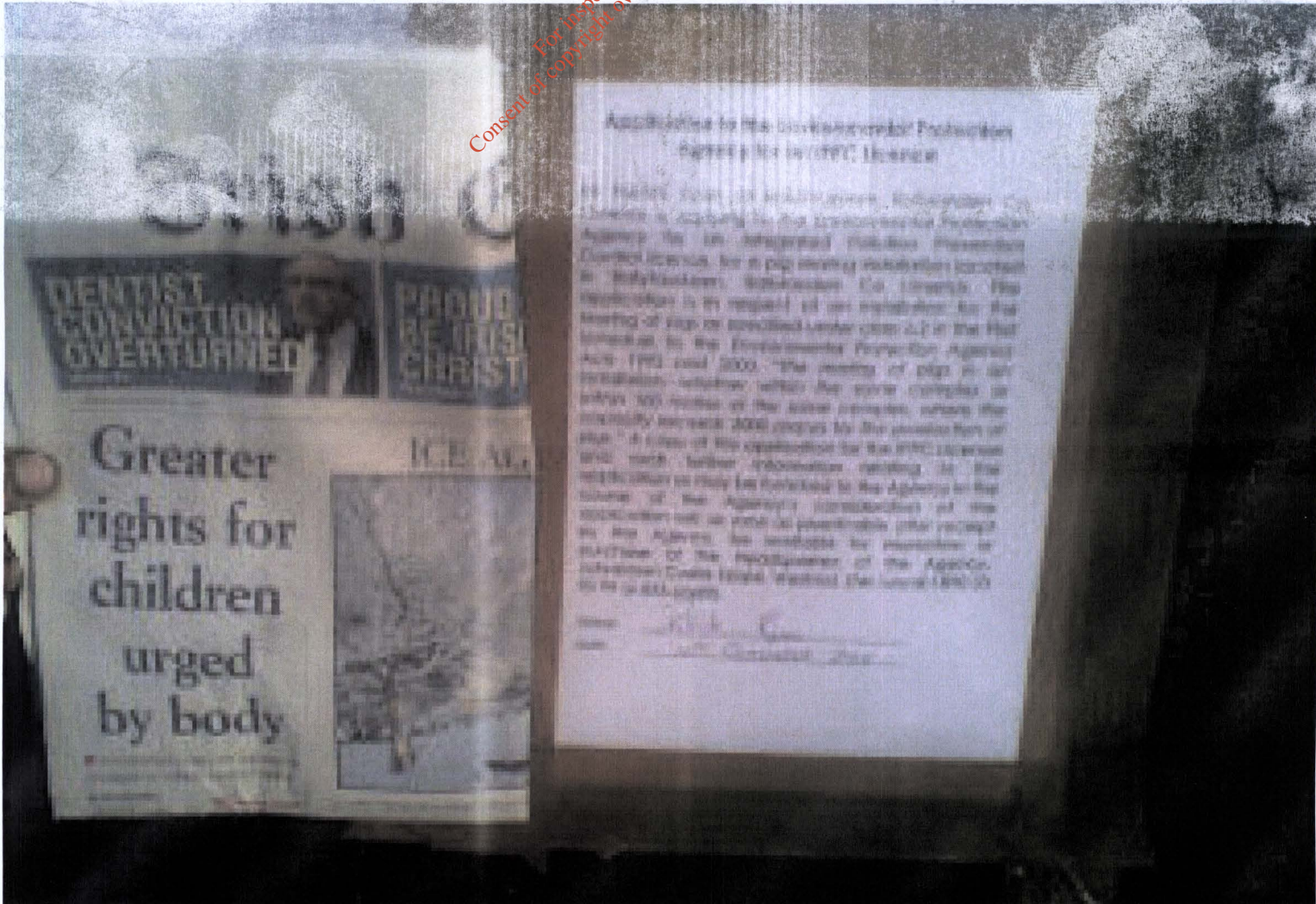

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Application by the Environmental Protection
Agency for a (EPC) Permit

The Health Dept. of Washington, D.C. is hereby notified by the Environmental Protection Agency for an integrated Pollution Prevention Permit for a pig raising operation located in Washington, D.C. The permit is required as an application for the permit of pig or swine under (21) of the National Sanitation Code. The permit of pig is an integrated permit with the same content as other 200 permit of the same nature, which the permit is used for the production of pig.
