Following the decision to review the existing IPPC licence (Reg. No. P0696-01) granted to Messrs Jim & Mark Wright T/A JMW Farms, 52 Cortynan Road, Tynan, County Armagh, BT60 4QZ, Northern Ireland, located at Crosses, Monaghan, County Monaghan, National Grid Reference E270342 N331030, On the 11th January 2011 the Agency proposed to grant a revised licence, subject to conditions (Reg. No. P0696-02), for class: 6.2: The rearing of pigs in an installation, whether within the same complex or within 100 metres of the same complex, where the capacity exceeds - 750 places for sows in a breeding unit, where a breeding unit means "a piggery in which pigs are bred and reared up to 30kg in weight". LOUTH COUNTY COUNCIL — We Paul Kelly and Gerry Friel intend to apply for permission for development at Aston Green, Aston Village, Drogheda. The development will consist of change of use from existing ancillary supermarket first floor offices to independent offices located above the supermarket (supermarket originally identified as Block A in Reg Ref 021626, 06312 & 081295).
