Introduction

Delete second last sentence of the 3rd paragraph *'The reason for this.....surface water connections'*.

Amend last sentence of the 3rd paragraph to read *'Treated effluent from the Irish Distillers Limited bypasses the Midleton WWTP and is discharged at the primary discharge point.'*

Condition

- 4.12.1 (v) Amend last sentence to read *'Any alternative design spill frequency and discharge volume, approved by the Agency, shall become part of this licence'*
- 5.6 Amend second last sentence to read *'The report on the programme of improvement shall be submitted to the Agency and the improvements shall be implemented by 31/12/2011.'*
Delete last sentence.
