Dear John,

Further to our telephone conversation this afternoon regarding the above IPPC License Application, we wish to revise the timescale for our response to the above request for further information.

As outlined in our letter of November 18, 2010, we had undertaken to respond by January 17, 2011. That timescale had been based on having responses to our third party consultations on the Appropriate Assessment completed at that stage.

We received responses to our consultations with both the National Parks and Wildlife Service and the Shannon Regional Fisheries Board on January 4 and are currently working to ensure that the comments and observations of both organizations are comprehensively addressed in the Appropriate Assessment.

Given the objective of compiling a comprehensive submission on all of the items requested in the Article 11 request, including a comprehensive Natura Impact Assessment in order to facilitate the Appropriate Assessment, Westland request an extension until February 4, 2011 to submit the requested information.
