TRANSFER OF AN IPPC LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 94 of the Environmental Protection Agency Acts,
1992 and 2007.

IPPC Licence Register No: **P0395-02**

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Environmental Protection Agency Acts, 1992 to 2007, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers IPPC licence Register Number P0395-02 and any associated amendments from AHP Manufacturing B.V. t/a Wyeth Nutritionals Ireland to Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals. IPPC Licence Register No P0395-02 licenses the carrying on of the IPPC activities set out below at Askeaton, County Limerick, subject to fifteen Conditions, as set out in the IPPC licence.

Activities Licensed:-

- the manufacture of dairy products where the processing capacity exceeds 50 million gallons of milk equivalents per year,
- the burning of any fuel in a boiler or furnace with a nominal heat output exceeding 50MW.

In accordance with Section 94 of the Acts, Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, that may arise.


REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Pursuant to Section 94(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like IPPC licence. Pursuant to Section 94(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on any of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the report of its inspector.
