In accordance with Regulation 28(1) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a Waste Water Discharge licence, subject to conditions, to Monaghan County Council in respect of the agglomeration named Glaslough.
