Please note that there is now a provision for summary data to be submitted in electronic format to the EPA. This Guidance Note contains information on the contents and structure of an AER. Licensees should have regard to this Guidance Note when fulfilling the reporting requirements of the licence.

As part of the enforcement of Waste Water Discharge Licences, it is proposed that the EPA will be undertaking audits and discharge monitoring to determine compliance with licence conditions. The EPA has developed an Audit Report which details the information that will be required to determine compliance or otherwise with the licence conditions.
