3. **Waste Water Discharge Licence Application**

The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use that the Agency approve the recommended decision to grant a Waste Water Discharge Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Licence; one Third-Party submissions and summary report of the Inspector.

Inspector's Report

The Directors noted the following typographical errors to the Inspector's Report.

2.1 Existing Discharges

The second and third sentences should read as follows 'The first three secondary discharges, *SW02, SW03, and SW04*, are from septic tanksCastletownbere Harbour. *GW05 and GW06* are the two remaining secondary discharges.'

6. Programme of Improvements

The last sentence should read as follows 'The Recommended Licence Action Plan Deadline of 2015.'

Recommended Licence

Introduction

Delete the last two sentences in the fourth paragraph starting 'Consultation with the DoEHLG Water Services Section the designated Castletownbere Shellfish Waters.'

Delete last paragraph 'The current treatment on the receiving environment.'

Conditions

- 4.14.2 Amend the first sentence of the condition to read 'For the purposes in 4.14.1 above, the licensee shall Bord Iascaigh Mhara (BIM).
- 4.14.3 Amend the last sentence of the condition as follows; 'Any such monitoring the parameters listed, *at the frequency specified*, in Schedule B.4 Ambient Monitoring.
- 5.4 Amend condition to read 'The licensee shall licence, by 31 December 2015 in order of this licence.'

Schedules

Schedule B Monitoring

Amend the Monitoring Frequency to Biannually in the Receiving Water Monitoring table of Schedule B.4.

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork County Council (Western Division) for the waste water discharge relating to the Castletownbere agglomeration, Register of Licence No D0297-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
