Dear Mr. Douglas

I refer to your fax dated 24 July 2010 and received by the Agency on 19 August 2010, which stated that the soils recovery facility the subject of your waste licence application located at Windtown, Dunsany, Co. Meath is closed and is no longer accepting waste. You also stated that you no longer wish to proceed with your application for a waste licence and requested a return of the application fee of €10,000.

I am to advise that in accordance with the provisions of article 21(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 the Agency cannot process your request for a withdrawal of your waste licence application until we have received confirmation from Meath County Council that the facility has been completed and restored in accordance with the requirements of Waste Permit No. WMP2006/13 which expired in July 2010, and to the satisfaction of Meath County Council.
