I refer to your application for a waste licence, which was received on the 22nd February 2011.

Following a site visit to the site on the 5th April 2011, I am to advise that, in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, the site notice in pursuance of Article 5 of said regulations does not comply with the provisions of Article 7 of said regulations. During the site visit of the 5th April 2011, a site notice was not fixed in a conspicuous position adjacent to a public road so as to be easily visible and legible by persons using the public road.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the Regulations to erect or fix a site notice in accordance with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 for a period of one month from 20th April 2011.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

- Confirm in writing that the site notice has been erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, referencing the date that the site notice has been erected or fixed at the site.
- Provide a copy of the notice and dated/verified photograph of notice in-situ.

In the circumstances you should make immediate arrangements to have the required information (1 signed original, 1 hardcopy and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay.
