Dear Ms Harrington,

I am to acknowledge receipt of your e-mail to the Agency received on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2011 in relation to the above referenced waste licence application.

I am to advise that, as the application process has reached the stage where the Agency has made its proposed decision, the Agency is prohibited from considering any correspondence which does not fulfil the requirements of Section 42 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2010. As your correspondence does not fulfil those requirements, for the reasons set out below, the Agency cannot consider it and consequently it is returned herewith.

Section 42(3) of the Acts

Objection received after the expiration of the appropriate period, i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> January 2011.

Section 42(4) of the Acts

Objection not accompanied by the appropriate fee, i.e. €200.

It should be noted, however, that the Agency is committed to openness, fairness and transparency in its decision making process and I can assure you that you will have access to all documentation in relation to this licence application including the report and recommendations of the technical committee and the final decision of the Agency.
