In accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a revised waste licence to Cork City Council, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Kinsale Road Landfill, Ballyphehane, Curraghconway, Inchisarsfield, South City Link Road, Cork. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

All documentation relating to the application is available for inspection on the Agency's website at www.epa.ie, including information on public participation and judicial review processes.

This decision was made following consideration of the objection and technical committee report to the Agency's Proposed Decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2010 and related Regulations.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0012-03, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and two copies of all items in the correspondence.

The Agency recommends that you meet with Siobhán McDonnell, Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, Regional Inspectorate, Inniscarra, Co. Cork, to discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.

Where the new licensable activity provided by W0012-03 has not yet commenced, you are required to provide adequate notice to the Agency (to both the Enforcement Inspector from the Office Of Environmental Enforcement, and the licensing inspector from the Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use) of the intended date of commencement of the activity.
