re: Notice in accordance with Regulation 25(c)(ii) of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007

Dear Mr. O'Friel.

I am to refer to the above referenced applications for waste water discharge certificates of authorisation relating to agglomerations named **Cecilstown (A319-01)** and **Lombardstown (A0327-01)**. Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Regulation 24 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Regulation 25(c)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps to supply the information detailed below:

REGULATION 24 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Having regard to the Natura Impact Statement (April 2011) received by the Agency 27th April 2011, please identify mitigation measures for the aforementioned agglomerations to ensure that the discharges are not likely to have a significant impact, in terms of maintaining favourable conservation status of the qualifying interests, on the designated European Site, Blackwater River (Cork/Waterford) Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.



In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one original plus one copy within **one** week of the date of this notice. In addition please submit one copy of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM (no file to exceed 10MB) to the Agency. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.

Please note that the application's register numbers for Cecilstown and Lombardstown are A0319-01 and A0327-01, respectively.
