Re: Waste Water Discharge Certificate of Authorisation – Reg no. A0031-01 – Clontibret WWTP, Co Monaghan

A chara.

A Waste Water Discharge Certificate of Authorisation (Reg no. A0031-01) was issued by the EPA in October 2010 in respect of the Clontibret WWFP, Co. Monaghan.

The Certificate of Authorisation authorises Monaghan County Council to discharge treated effluent from the plant directly to waters. However, Monaghan County Council is currently involved in an Interreg IVA- supported project known as ANSWER (Agricultural Need for Sustainable Willow Effluent Recycling). The Council plans to plant a 10 hectare site with willow and to use the treated effluent from the Clontibret wastewater treatment plant to irrigate the willow coppice. Consequently, our Certificate of Authorisation will need to be amended to reflect this change.

The Willow Short rotation coppicing project is only in its early stages – we are currently seeking out suitable sites for the plantation. However, we are hopeful that the trees will be planted in 2012 – with the need for irrigation commencing in the 2013 growing season. Consequently, we need to retain the right to discharge the effluent to waters until such time as we are ready to switch to the irrigation of the trees.
