Land Use:

The historic landfill appears as a flat & level topography. The site is currently privately owned and it is currently used for agricultural activities. It appears that the area is mainly used for grazing, although it is possible that that silage or hay may have been harvested in summer months.

Waterford County Council have discussed with the current landowners (Mr. Richard O’ Hara & Mrs. Rita O’ Hara) that further works were required for completion of the risk assessment as set out in the Code of Practice for environmental risk assessment for unregulated waste disposal sites. Approval and co-operation has been sought by Waterford County Council from the current landowners.
