## ENVIRONMENTAL LICENSING PROGRAMME MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Proposal for a Clerical Amendment to Waste Licence Register Number **W0129-02** held by **Murphy Environmental Hollywood Limited** in relation to a waste facility at Hollywood Great, Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin.

### Introduction

Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd operates an inert landfill at the above location. The licensee is authorised to accept and dispose of up to 500,000 tonnes per annum of inert construction and demolition waste and dredging spoils. The facility was licensed on 4 December 2002. A revised licence was issued on 21 May 2008. There is currently an application for a revised licence (register number W0129-03) before the Agency.

### Details of the proposal for clerical amendment

A typographical error has been detected in W0129-02 that requires correction: Condition 8.9.5 incorrectly refers to a Council Decision<sup>1</sup> as 2003/22/EC instead of 2003/33/EC. Other references in the licence to the Council Decision are correct. The request for amendment of the licence was made by the Office of Environmental Enforcement.

I consider it appropriate to also correct a further typographical error in condition 8.9.5: amend the word "establishing" to "established".

Section 42B(2) of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011 states that "the Agency shall, where appropriate, consult with the holder of the licence before exercising the power" to amend a waste licence in the manner proposed. I consider it neither appropriate nor necessary to consult with the holder of the licence in this case. The amendments are of a nature that activities at the facility will not be impacted in any way and there are no potential grounds for objecting to the proposed amendments.

### Recommendation

I recommend amendment of condition 8.9.5 of the licence.
