I refer to the application for the Transfer of a licence submitted to the Agency on 13th September 2010 from Dear Waste Company Limited (Licensor) to Envi-Waste Ltd (Transferee).

So as to progress with the assessment of your joint application and in accordance with Sections 47(4) and 53(1) of the Waste Management Acts 1992 to 2010, the Agency requires that you submit the following information:

- Letter of agreement from OEH for the monies/securities required for the liabilities arising from an approved risk assessment of the licensed activities on the site;
- Letter of agreement from OEH for the monies/securities required for the costs associated with the closure and remediation of the site;
- Letter of agreement from OEH regarding the financial provisions that the proposed Transferee is making for the liabilities and the closure and remediation costs referred to above.

Please liaise with your OEH Inspector to have these arranged. We request that you submit this information to the Agency by the 30th April 2011. The Agency reminds you that the licence cannot be transferred without this information.
