I refer to our previous correspondence in early May 2011 in relation to the waste licence application from Murray Waste Recycling (MWR) Ltd. currently with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

MWR is seeking clarification from the EPA in relation to waste activities at the site, which are currently managed under the current waste permit which was granted in January 2009 under the 1998 Waste Permit Regulations.

As you are aware MWR submitted the waste licence application in early February 2009, in accordance with Section 4 of the Waste Management (Facility Permit and Registration) Regulations 2007, as amended, where a waste permit shall remain valid if an application for a waste licence is made to the Agency within 180 working days of the coming into force of these Regulations.

MWR wish to clarify, if, on expire of this permit in January 2012, if a new permit application to the local authority is required or can waste management operations at the site continue under the current waste permit until such time a decision is made with regards to the waste licence.

MWR is aware that the Agency is awaiting the submission of an Environmental Impact Statement as previously discussed with the Agency.
