As you are aware, on Friday 10th December 2010, Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd. (MEHL) submitted an application to An Bord Pleanála in respect of a Strategic Infrastructure Development for a proposed Integrated Waste Management Facility at Hollywood Great, Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin.

The site is a former quarry and is currently operating as an EPA-licensed landfill (Licence No. W0129-02), under planning permissions Register Refs. F04A/0363 and F07A/0262. The facility currently accepts construction and demolition and other inert wastes. It is proposed that the facility will be developed for the acceptance and landfilling of non-biodegradable inert, non-hazardous and hazardous wastes.

This purpose of this letter is to inform you of MEHL's intention to submit an application for a Waste Licence to the Environmental Protection Agency.

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APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE

Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd. (MEHL), Hollywood Great, Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin, is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a Waste Licence for a proposed integrated waste management facility at Hollywood Great, Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin (National Grid Reference E315810, N258015). The site is currently operating as an EPA licensed inert landfill (Licence W0129-02).

The proposed EPA licensed area is 39.8 hectares. It is proposed that the facility will be developed for the acceptance and landfilling of a range of non-biodegradable waste streams. Wastes will be classified under one of the following classes of landfill: inert, non-hazardous or hazardous, as specified under the EU Landfill Directive (1999). Certain hazardous wastes (e.g. ash from waste-to-energy facilities deemed to be hazardous) will be pre-treated by means of a solidification process prior to landfilling. On-site waste recovery operations will be retained. The total waste input will be up to 500,000 tonnes per annum, which is consistent with the current EPA Waste Licence. It is proposed that the facility will operate to accept approved wastes on an all-island basis. The proposed lifetime of the facility is 25 years, so as to fully complete the infill and restoration of the former quarry, in keeping with the surrounding landscape.

The proposed development involves the construction of: a) specially engineered landfill cells for inert, non-hazardous and hazardous wastes, b) a solidification plant with associated storage tanks and silos, c) a storage building, d) an administration office building, e) new weighbridges, f) car parking, g) an ESB substation/switch room, h) internal haul routes, i) surface water ponds and leachate management facilities, j) a temporary viewing platform for visitors from which the geology of the quarry faces can be viewed, and k) ancillary site works and landscaping. A new facility entrance is also proposed from the County Road LP1080.

The relevant waste disposal and waste recovery activities, as per the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2010 and the Waste Management Licensing Regulations, 2004 (SI 395 of 2004), to which this application relate are:

Licensed Waste Disposal Activities, in accordance with the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2010

Class 1: Deposit on, in or under land (including landfill)
 Class 5: Specially engineered landfill, including placement into lined discrete cells, which are capped and isolated from one another and the environment. This is the principal activity.

Class 13: Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced

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Class 3: Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds
 Class 4: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials

Class 13: Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced

A planning application in respect of a Strategic Infrastructure Development has been made to An Bord Pleanála in respect of this proposed development. The proposed development relates to the provision of an establishment to which the Major Accident Directive applies. An Environmental Impact Statement will be submitted to the EPA to accompany the Waste Licence Application. A copy of the Waste Licence Application, accompanying Environmental Impact Statement, and any further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the EPA in the course of the EPA's consideration of the application, will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the EPA, be available for inspection or purchase at EPA Headquarters, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, Co. Wexford (during normal working hours).

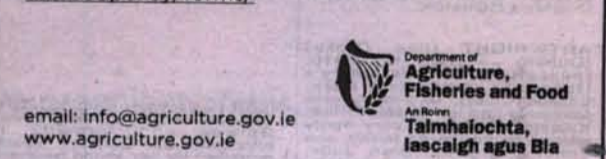
