Notice for the purposes of Section 87 (1)(b) of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2011 - Review by Agency of IPPC Licence

Dear Mr. Shiel,

I am to advise, in accordance with section 87(1)(b) of the EPA Acts, that the Agency intends initiating a review of your existing IPPC licence **P0395-02**, for an installation located at: **Askeaton, County Limerick.** 

The review is being initiated to bring your licence into compliance with recent amendments to legislation including those Statutory Instruments listed below:

- (1) European Communities Environmental Objectives (Surface Waters) Regulations 2009
- (2) European Communities Environmental Objectives (Groundwater) Regulations 2010

Please submit one signed original, one hardcopy and 2 copies on CD-ROM in electronic searchable PDF format by 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011.

For the purposes of the review, the reference number in the Register of Licences is No. P0395-03.

On 28<sup>th</sup> July 2011, a newspaper notice will be published in the Irish Independent in accordance with Article 16(1) of the Environmental Protection Agency (Licensing) Regulations, stating that the EPA is initiating a review of your licence.
