'Ep' means annual energy produced as heat or electricity calculated with energy in the form of electricity being multiplied by 2.6 and heat produced for commercial use multiplied by 1.1(GJ/year).

*Eff means annual energy input to the system from fuels contributing to the production of steam (GJ year).

'Ew' means annual energy contained in the treated waste calculated using the net calorific value of the waste (GJ year).

'Ei' means annual energy imported excluding Ew and Ef(GJ year).
