## WASTE MANAGEMENT ACTS, 1996 to 2008

### TRANSFER OF A WASTE LICENCE

Decision of the Agency, under Section 47(5) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011

*Waste Licence Register No:* **W0167-02**

The Agency, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011, for the reasons hereinafter set out, hereby transfers waste licence register number W0167-02 from Indaver Ireland (Branch of Indaver NV), 4 Haddington Terrace, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin to Indaver Ireland Limited, 4 Haddington Terrace, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin. Waste Licence Register No W0167-02 licenses the carrying on of the waste activities set out below at Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath subject to twelve Conditions, as set out in the waste licence.

*Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Third Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011*

Class 7.	Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 5 or paragraphs 8 to 10 of this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcination).
Class 8.	Incineration on land or at sea. [Principal Activity]
Class 12.	Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
Class 13.	Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.



*Licensed Waste Disposal Activities in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011*

Class 3.	Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds.
Class 4.	Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.
Class 9.	Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy.
Class 13.	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

In accordance with Section 47(6) of the Acts, Indaver Ireland Limited is deemed to have assumed and accepted all liabilities, requirements and obligations provided for in or arising under the licence, regardless of how and in respect of what period, including a period prior to the transfer of the licence, they may arise.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

Pursuant to Section 47(5)(a) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Indaver Ireland Limited is entitled to be regarded as a fit and proper person to be granted a like waste licence. Pursuant to Section 47(5)(b) of the Acts, the Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that Indaver Ireland Limited has made adequate financial provision to discharge the financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on each of the activities to which the licence relates, or in consequence of ceasing to carry on any of those activities. In reaching this decision the Agency has considered the application and supporting documentation received from the joint applicants and the report of its inspector.
