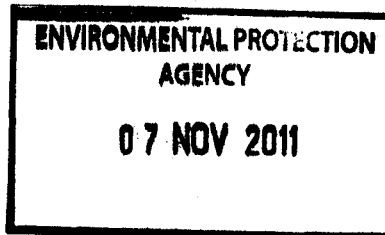

Dear Ms Bolger,

On behalf of O'Regan's Quarry Products Ltd (O'Regan's), we enclose the requested application to review the Waste Licence for the facility at Tulligmore, Dripsey, County Cork.

The facility has not accepted any waste since the Licence was granted. The Licence authorises a seasonal emission point to surface water. This discharge was previously regulated under a Trade Effluent Licence (TEL) granted by Cork County Council. The application for the TEL included an assessment of the impact of the discharge on the receiving surface water course. A copy of the TEL application is in Attachment 1 and it includes the information on the emission requested in Section B, C and D 1 of the Licence Review Form.

O'Regan's have developed a documented Environmental Management System for the site, a copy of which is in Attachment 2. It includes the information requested in Section D2 and describes the facility layout and operation; procedures that are in place to prevent, eliminate or reduce emissions from site activities; waste management procedures and the measures to prevent accidents and limit their consequences. O'Regan's has also developed an Energy & Resource Management Programme to ensure that energy and resources are managed in an efficient manner. A copy of the programme is in Attachment 3.

I understand that O'Regan's have already submitted the application fee of €3000.
