Introduction

Amend 2nd sentence in the 2nd Paragraph to read as follows; 'Under the Water Services Investment Programme (WSIP) it is proposed Rye Valley Food Limited (IPPC Licence Register No. P0806-01)'.

Amend 2nd sentence in the 4th Paragraph to read as follows; 'The sewer system has Investment Programme *and* works are due to be completed during 2011, resulting waste water *treatment* plant, being decommissioned'.

Conditions

1.8.1 Amend to read as follows; 'Where a treatment to the waste water works *that* are subject licensee shall notify the Agency'.

1.8.2 Amend to read as follows; 'Where the licensee has received for the *infrastructural improvements* in Condition 1.8.1 above, the licence is required'.
