Dear Mr. Meaney,

I am a consultant for Clean (Irl) Refuse & Recycling ltd. and am currently working on the response to your letter dated 11th August 2011 'Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended'.

With reference to Table B.7.1 of the Waste Licence Application form, I wish to confirm that my Client's activities do not come under R1 of the fourth schedule in relation to Waste Recovery Operations for use principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy.

The licence application involves a Biostabilisation Plant with energy recovery:

- Combined Heat Power Plant utilizing 1,720,000 m³ biogas generated from dry fermentation giving 526 KWel of electricity for supply to the facility and potential export from the site to the National Grid
- 558 kW of recoverable thermal output (180 degrees C) is generated by the CHP plant.

The principal activity is R3 which now includes gasification, so I believe that the CHP activity is captured in R3 and NOT R1 is intended for incineration facilities.

When we previously queried the CHP in relation to the WID with the EPA in 2008, it was confirmed that the CHP did not come under the WID.

Can you please confirm the above before I submit the response to your letter.
