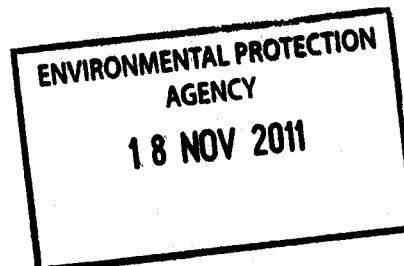


The Clean Ireland Refuse and Recycling Ltd Waste Licence application has been deemed compliant by Ms. O Callaghan and I am writing to you to request that this Waste Licence is brought to the Board for review before Christmas 2011. Clean Ireland has been struggling to comply with their current waste tonnage limits, as it was anticipated in 2008 that the Licence would be in place at this juncture. As it stands they are unable to expand their business and potential business is being lost on a month by month basis.

The history of the application involved

- 1) The original Waste Licence application to the EPA on 22nd December 2008
- 2) An amended EIS & Licence Application form was submitted on the 17th December 2009. The application was been amended following a meeting with Environmental Protection Agency on 3rd June 2009. The nature of the changes to the application were based on a revision of the composting process; from (i) composting and pasteurisation to (ii) dry anaerobic digestion, composting and pasteurisation. The changes were made in light of the new animal by-product regulations which came out earlier that year.

On behalf of the Company, Directors Michael and John O'Donoghue, I would be very grateful if you could progress the application with urgency, to allow Clean Ireland Refuse and Recycling ltd. reach their commercial potential as soon as possible.
