I write this complaint in relation to the application submitted by Biocore on 16 Apr 2011 regarding the waste licence W0274-01

2. AD Power Roscommon Ltd is 100% subsidiary of BioPower Ltd and any change in the company structure should be endorsed by the company directors: Walter Ryan-Purcell or Donall O Laoire.

5. The waste facility permit WEP-RN-09-0001-01 from the Roscommon County Council is granted to Biopower Ltd and not to Biocore Environmental AD1 (Waste Permit, attachment B.3)

With all these attempts from different parties to get the go ahead from EPA, it is obvious that Ballinphuill site is attracting some ambitious developers who are interested in making money without considering the impact of such project on Tibohine.

To the best of my knowledge Biopower Ltd who applied first for the waste licence is no longer interested in bringing waste to Tibohine due to the huge opposition from locals.

The poor and sub standard EIS submitted to EPA by Biopower Ltd in 2009 was prepared by Biocore Environmental Ltd which was hired to develop the Tibohine facility and other sites in Ireland. I strongly request that the EPA should consider this application as null and void as it contains untruthfull and inaccurate information.
