4. Clarification on Fermoy Town and Environs Waste Water Discharge Licence Reg No. D0058-01

The Directors considered documentation from the Environmental Licensing Programme, OCLR, clarifying issues raised by the Board at their meeting of the 25th October 2011 with regard to a potential discharge point in the centre of the town. K Creed gave a verbal presentation. Following discussion the Directors accepted the clarifications as detailed in the Memorandum dated 17 November 2011. The Directors further noted that the emissions from SW4 will be regulated under the Waste Water Discharge Licence and therefore upheld their decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Cork County Council Northern Division for the waste water discharge relating to the Fermoy Town & Environs agglomeration, Register of Licence No D0058-01. It was also recommended that OEA review the appropriateness of the sampling location downstream of SW4.
