Dear Sir/Madam,

In response to the notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations received from Mr Stuart Huskisson on 24th October 2011, please find updated information related to financial commitments or liabilities.

As you may be aware, Mr Binman Group (including Greenport Environmental Ltd) was placed into receivership on Thursday 27th October, 2011, subsequent to receipt of your notice. Bank of Scotland (Ireland) have appointed receivers Padraic Monaghan and Kieran Wallace, KPMG, to operate the business in the interim and sell the business as a going concern. I was appointed by the Receivers, as General Manager to the Mr Binman Group.

If the Greenport Environmental development is to proceed in Foynes, the Greenport Environmental facility will be developed as an AD/Composting facility by any new owners of the company following the receivership process. Having the Waste Licence in place for the development will be important in securing new owners as it is a condition of planning that the facility development can only commence once the Waste licence is in place.

If the facility is purchased by new owners and developed, it is likely to operate as a viable business and is likely to be in a position to meet any financial commitments or liabilities that will be entered into or incurred in carrying on the activity to which the application relates or in consequence of ceasing to carry

out that activity as the facility operation. The company will receive income primarily from gate fees and feed-in tariffs received from electricity generated and delivered to the national grid.

Should the Agency require further commitment in this regard, Greenport Environmental Ltd(under receivership) is requesting an open ended extension to the timeline for providing further information in this regard until such time as a new owner for the company is in place following the receivership process.
