4. **Waste Water Discharge Licence Application**

**Recommended Licence**

***Introduction***

Amend the 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence in the 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph as follows; 'Condition 4.18 of the licence requires the licensee ... .. primary discharge point to an alternative receiving *water and/or for the upgrade of the WWTP to provide adequate hydraulic and biological treatment capacity, in order to achieve* ... .. alternative receiving water.'

Amend the last sentence in the 5<sup>th</sup> paragraph as follows; 'Condition 4.19 of the licence ... .. drain to cease *by 31 December 2013*, unless otherwise agreed by the Agency.'

***Conditions***

- 4.18** Amend first sentence as follows; 'The licensee shall, within six months of the date of grant ... .. primary discharge point to an alternative receiving *water and/or for the upgrade of the WWTP to provide adequate hydraulic and biological treatment capacity, in order to achieve* ... .. appropriate to the receiving water.'

4.19 Amend first sentence as follows: 'The discharges from the primary discharge ... shall cease by 31 December 2013, unless otherwise agreed by the Agency'.

Amend condition 3.4.2(g) to read as follows; 'comparison of monitoring results against standard reference values ... .. Objectives (Surface Waters) Regulations 2009.'  
Delete condition 3.4.3.

##### **Objection 6. Condition 3.8**

Delete the first sentence of the second paragraph as follows; '*The site shall be ... .. at all time*'.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a draft Certificate of Authorisation, as modified, to Cork County Council for their facility at Newmarket, County Cork, Register of Licence No H0001-01.
