

Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for an IPPC Licence

Mr Patrick Ryan, of Ballyfauskeen, Ballylanders Co Limerick (Grid Reference E178991 N123370) is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency for an Integrated Pollution Prevention Control licence, for a pig rearing installation located in Ballyfauskeen, Ballylanders Co Limerick. The application is in respect of an installation for the rearing of pigs as specified under class 6.2 in the First Schedule to the Environmental Protection Agency Acts 1992 and 2007. *"The rearing of pigs in an installation, whether within the same complex or within 100 metres of the same complex, where the capacity exceeds 2000 places for the production of pigs."* An Environmental Impact Assessment Statement has been submitted previously to Limerick County Council, and same is submitted in support of this application.
