Re: Notice in accordance with Articles (104) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr Huskisson.

I refer to your letter of 26 January 2012. As you will be aware Kieran Wallace and I were appointed Joint Receivers over the assets and undertakings of the above company on 27 October 2011.

The business and assets of Greenport Environmental Limited, which in the main comprise the property and facility at Foynes, have been advertised for sale. I am confident that a purchaser will be secured for the business and assets.

Greenport Environmental Ltd wishes to progress with the current waste license application or at least for the application to remain active.

In order to satisfy Section 40(7) (c) of the Waste Management Acts(1996-2011), Greenport Environmental Ltd. respectfully requests an open ended timeline to complete the receivership process and secure a purchaser. At that stage, Greenport Environmental Ltd. will be in a better position to provide clarification on any financial commitments or liabilities entered into or incurred in carrying on the activity. This is a matter which will be raised with any new purchaser during the due diligence process.

If a purchaser of the facility in Foynes does not plan to develop the site as an AD/Composting facility, Greenport Environmental Ltd. will then request the withdrawal of the waste license application.
