

**OBJECTION SUBMISSION**

Subject: Objection to Waste Licence Application W0140-04 in respect of Nurendale Limited trading as Panda Waste Services Limited at Rathdrinagh, Beauparc, Navan, Co. Meath.

**OBJECTION SUMMARY:** We the undersigned, are extremely concerned about the proposals and object to the same proposals outlined in the licence application W0140-04 and subsequent amendments. including construction and operation of a Dry Fermentation building [Shed 4], Refuses derived fuel [RDF] processes [Shed 3], Bio-mass furnace, associated gas production processes, Combined Heat and Power [CHP] furnace, generators, flares and ancillary works at Rathdringah, Beauparc, Navan, Co. Meath.

*The following are a brief outline of some of the reasons for our objections:*

**[1]** The impact that the proposed facility will have on the air and also the water quality in the area concerned. The Boyne Valley is world renowned as site of wonderful natural beauty and the proposed facility would be detrimental to the image of the area.

**[2]** The probable pollution of the Lougher river that runs adjacent to the proposed facility. This river runs into the Boyne about 100 yards upstream of the pumping station at Donore that supplies water to the surrounding area and also to Drogheda, one of the main towns in the north east. This area is known to flood in winter after heavy rain and in the event of a contamination from the facility during a flood there is a real possibility of contaminants getting into the drinking water supply.

**[3]** The impact that a possible spill of pollution would have on Salmon and Seatrout spawning beds and the eco system downstream.

*We in the Rossin and Slane Angling Club have been operating a Catch and Release policy on the Boyne for the past 5 years in conjunction with Inland Fisheries Ireland in order to protect depleted Salmon stocks. any release of harmful chemicals into any of the above mentioned rivers would set this programme back many years and would undo all that has already been achieved.*

**[4]** At a time in Ireland's history when the country is on it's knees financially and especially in the area concerned where tourism means much to the local economy, it is essential that the Boyne Valley is portrayed as a pristine habitat for wild life and everything that is rich in natural resources. A facility such as the one proposed is the last thing that is needed in the area and all it would be is an ugly scar on a beautiful landscape.
