You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:


### **ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS**

1. It is noted in your letter dated 16 November 2011, that you wish to proceed with your waste licence review application. Please clarify how Mr. Binman (in receivership) intends to satisfy the requirements of Section 40(7)(c) of the Waste Management Acts (1996 -2011).

Please supply the information in the form of a one (1) original plus one (1) copy in hardcopy format within **three weeks** of the date of this notice. In addition submit sixteen (16) copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM. Please note that all maps/drawings should not exceed A3 in size.
