I refer to the review of your Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) licence, which was received on 29 September 2011.


I am to advise that in accordance with the provisions of Section 90(7) of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2011, you are requested to supply the following additional information so that the Agency may complete a comprehensive assessment:

- Indicate the location of the water abstraction point; please give details if available of the registration of this abstraction with the local authority.
- Give details and identify the drain containing 'non-contact cooling water'. Indicate for all storm water drainage, if they pass through oil interceptors/silt traps. Give details of drains that do not pass through an interceptor. Give details as to the class of all interceptors if used.

In the circumstances you should make immediate arrangements to have the required information (1 signed original, 1 hardcopy and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay. Your response to this request should be directed to Noeleen Keavey Administration Officer, Office of Climate, Licensing & Resource Use.

It should be noted that where there is failure to comply with the above requirements within **5 weeks** of this notice, the Agency may proceed with its consideration of this application in the absence of the information requested.
