Dear Mr. Johnston

I am to refer to your letter of 18 January 2012, received by the Agency on 23 January 2012 notifying the Agency of your withdrawal of the above referenced waste water discharge licence applications.

The Agency hereby acknowledges that you have formally withdrawn the above referenced waste water discharge licence applications. That being the case it is no longer the function of the Agency to consider any documentation received by it which relates to the above applications.

It is noted that Monaghan County Council intend submitting Certificate of Authorisation applications for these agglomerations in the near future. On receipt of these applications a refund of €21,000 will issue i.e €7,000 for each application withdrawn with the balance being retained for the Certificate of Authorisation fee of €3,000.
