**Objection to Proposed Determination of an Application for an IPPC Licence**

**Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendment;

***A.5. – Condition 6.13 – Noise Monitoring***

Amend condition 6.13 to read:

Noise

‘The Licensee shall carry out a noise survey of the site operations every two years *or as otherwise agreed by the Agency*. The Survey ... .. by the Agency’.

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Queally Pig Slaughtering Limited, for their facility at, Grannagh, County Kilkenny, Register of Licence No P0175-02 subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
