

CORK COUNTY COUNCIL: MSD Brinny Company, (formerly Schering Plough Brinny Company) intend to apply for Planning Permission for the following developments at their facility at Brinny, Innishannon, Co. Cork. The development will consist of:

a)Erection of four 250m³ (13 metres high) storage tanks in the area of the existing Waste Water Treatment Facility, involving the demolition of two existing redundant shed buildings.

b)Removal / Demolition of two existing redundant waste water treatment tanks and the construction of a Decanter, Control and plant room Building of 211m² (7.5 metres high) in the area of the existing Waste Water Treatment Facility, above a redundant bund that will become a basement space designated for future use as a plant room

c)The construction of a 6.25m² (3.3 metres high) Storm Water Monitoring Building, at the southern end of the facility. Associated site works will consist of paths and landscaping. B. AXIS Re plc maintains its company filings in the Companies Registration Office, Ireland, under registered number 353220 in accordance with Article 3(2) of Directive 68/151/EEC.

Specialty Fenchurch PLC maintains its company filings in Companies House, England and Wales, under registered number 08010250 in accordance with Article 3(2) of Directive 68/151/EEC.
