Re.: **Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd. (MEHL), EPA Ref. W0129-03**
Response to Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

We refer to your letter of 23rd March 2012 and wish to respond as follows (EPA text is included as ***Bold Italics***).

1. With reference to the disposal activities selected from the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Act 1996 to 2011, and the text "this activity relates to the deposition of inert material" in attachment B.7.5, explain further the relevance of class D1 to the proposed waste activities at the facility. State whether any part of the existing or proposed landfill is not "specially engineered landfill" according to class D5.

Class D1 is licensed under W0129-02; the Waste Licence Application W0129-03 seeks to retain waste activities licensed under W0129-02.

In the context of W0129-03, it is possible that some final restoration and contouring works would fall under the class 'D1'. Material would be proven to meet acceptance criteria for class 'D1' such that only clean materials are used.

2. Explain the relevance of class R4 – recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds – in the context of the stated intention to recover metal from wastes delivered to the facility. State what wastes will be processed for metal recovery.

Class R4 is licensed under W0129-02; the Waste Licence Application W0129-03 seeks to retain waste activities licensed under W0129-02.

Class R4 may apply to Construction & Demolition waste accepted to the facility. Also, there may be the opportunity to extract metals from bottom ash, for example, depending on the type of recovery activities applied at the source site. Recovery of metals from waste is in keeping with the provisions of the waste hierarchy.

3. With reference to the "active waste recovery area" and "the waste recovery activities" referred to in Figure D.2.1 and Table D.2.3 respectively of the application and shown as "inert recovery area" on drawing PP_WLA_14_01, describe the nature and purpose of the waste activities proposed and the nature of waste to be accepted for such treatment.

This makes reference to activities currently licensed under W0129-02, i.e. the recovery of inert/Construction & Demolition-type materials, and could typically involve screening or grading of materials to facilitate onward use/recovery.

The information contained herein is deemed not to impinge on the non-technical summary of the Waste Licence Application or EIS; no revisions to drawings arise from the information contained herein.
