Our current application to you includes a request for extension of the hours of waste acceptance, and for unrestricted hours of waste dispatch for the above facility. The existing and proposed hours of waste acceptance, as per the application, are shown in the table below;

Current	Proposed	Period
08:00 – 18:30	06:00 – 20:00	Mon - Fri
08:00 – 14:00	06:00 – 14:00	Sat

Following recent consultation with the Carranstown Residents Association, we write to propose that the existing hours of waste acceptance (Mon – Fri) of 08:00 to 18:30 be changed to allow for only one additional hour in the morning. Therefore the hours of waste acceptance would be 07:00 to 18:30 Monday to Friday. We propose that the waste acceptance hours on Saturdays remain unchanged.


For clarity, the following table shows the revised hours of waste acceptance requested:

Current	Proposed	Period
08:00 – 18:30	07:00 – 18:30	Mon - Fri
08:00 – 14:00	No Change	Sat

For the dispatch of residues/wastes from site, it is proposed to follow the new hours of waste acceptance requested above, with a provision that in exceptional circumstances, residues/wastes be allowed to depart the site outside these hours with written notification provided to the EPA no later than 10:00 on the following working day.
